This morning's organ music features two organists on the bench — staying out of each other's way is just one consideration when four hands and four feet are working in close quarters! The two pieces we are playing are movements from larger works written by English and German composers. Samuel Wesley was Charles's son - known as the "English Mozart", he wrote many works for organ, but much of his choral writing for the Roman church (to which he had converted) was never published. Gustav Merkel was a prolific composer of organ whose works are reminiscent of Mendelssohn and Rheinberger.


